First: International Efforts

- Accession of the Sultanate of Oman to the UN Convention against Corruption under Royal Decree No. 64/2013
- Accession of the Sultanate of Oman to the Convention on Combating Bribery of Foreign Public Officials in International Business Transactions under Royal Decree No. 41/2016
- Completing the first and second review cycles of the implementation of the UN Convention against Corruption
- Participating in reviewing the implementation of the UN Convention against Corruption by a number of state parties such as Palestine. Cook Islands and the Republic of Costa Rica
- Participating in conferences and meetings related to the UN Convention against corruption such as the Conference of State Parties to the Convention and meetings of government experts
- Following- up international reports and indicators such as Corruption Perceptions Index
- Cooperating with the UN Office on Drugs and Crime
- Participating in the International Anti-corruption Conference organized by Transparency International

Second: Regional Efforts

- Sultanate of Oman's ratification of the Arab Convention against Corruption under Royal Decree No. 28/2014
- Participating in the conferences and meetings held at the level of the Arab Convention against Corruption
- Cooperating with the MENA-OECD
- Participating in the meetings of the Ministerial Committee, the undersecretaries Committee and the Committee of Experts on Anti-Corruption in the GCC countries



Third: Local Efforts

A. Follow-up and Implementation

- ♦ Adopting the National Integrity Promotion Plan (2022-2030)
- SAI assumed the task of combating corruption and following -up and implementing the UN Convention against Corruption
- Forming a group of experts from the Sultanate of Oman to review the implementation of the UN Convention against Corruption
- **Establishing the National Centre for Financial Information**
- **Establishing the National Competitiveness Office**
- Forming the National Committee and the Technical Committee on Combating Money Laundering and Financing of Terrorism
- Forming the National Team to conduct the national risk- assessment
- Forming a committee to promote integrity and combat corruption in SAI
- E-linking the systems of government authorities and companies

B. National Legislation

- Issuing and amending a number of legislations related to corruption crimes such as the Penal Code and the Anti-Money Laundering and the Anti-Terrorism Financing Law
- Considering the amendment of the Protection of Public Fund and Avoidance of Conflict of Interest Law in order to promote transparency and measures taken to combat corruption
- ♦ Taking legal measures against a number of violations that are considered as corruption cases
- **Solution** Services Issuing and amending financial disclosure forms for government officials

C. Awareness and Integrity Promotion

- Implementing media and awareness activities and events in the field of promoting integrity and combating corruption in various media outlets such as TV, radio, seminars, lectures, digital media and exhibitions
- Implementing awareness programs in schools and universities
